

SPECIFICATIONS

1. Scope of Work:

- a. Bush (uprooted) and vegetation clearing on the surface, slope, and, the edges of the drainage channel to eliminate hibernating site for land or water dangerous animals as well as hiding sites for criminals.
- b. Grass cutting to be not more than 100mm above the ground
- c. Removal of natural stream pollutants and foreign objects to unblock normal flow.
- d. No protected tree species beyond 1.5m from the stormwater edge shall be destroyed.
- e. Loading and the disposal of debris, trash and sedimentation particles.
- f. Area to each site may not exceed extent provided in Table 2 below.

3. Existing Conditions

- a. Existence and continuous sewage flow in the stormwater drainage channels
- b. The bulk water and sewer pipes on the surface as well as underground
- c. Transnet railway infrastructure
- d. Municipal electrical and road infrastructure
- e. Partial lined stormwater drainage channel
- f. Aqua animals
- g. Vegetation (medium to dense)
- h. Unstable and soft grounds
- i. Informal peasants

4. Conditions for work execution

- a. No work will be allowed without both the Local Municipality and the Vhembe District Municipality representative on site
- b. All exiting service to be identified and protected before physical works executions.
- c. Transnet toe earthworks not to be disturbed during the vegetation control and the clearing.
- d. No damage to existing infrastructure will be accepted.
- e. Failure to comply with the conditions of works execution will automatically nullifies the order. The service provider will be liable for the repairs of the damaged infrastructure.
- f. The municipality will cancel the order for poor performance by the service provider.
- g. No compensation will be made toward terminated order due to poor performance by the service provider.
