



CALL FOR NOMINATIONS OF PERSONS TO BE APPOINTED AS MEMBERS OF THE MUSINA MUNICIPAL PLANNING TRIBUNAL AND APPEAL AUTHORITY

Musina Local Municipality following a resolution made by Council at its meeting held on 24 August 2024, hereby invites nominations for members of the public to be appointed to the Musina municipal planning tribunal and appeal authority for its term of office in terms of section 35(1) of spatial planning and land use management act, 2013 (act no. 16 of 2013), read together with Section 14 & 16 of Musina Local Municipality Spatial Planning and Land Use Management By-Law, 2016.

Attributes: The Nominees for both MPT and Appeal Authority must be registered with the relevant professional bodies, must have leadership qualities and must have knowledge and experience of spatial planning, land use management, Environmental Management, engineering, land development and legal background.

Terms of office: The period of office of members will be for 5 years calculated from the date of appointment of such members by the Musina Local Municipality.

The nominees for Municipal Planning Tribunal and Appeal Authority must meet the minimum requirements as indicated below:

AREA OF EXPERTISE	QUALIFICATION	EXPERIENCE
1.1. Legal	Registered Attorney/Advocate	5 years or more
1.2. Environment	Registered Environmentalist	5 years or more
1.3. Town and Regional Planning/ Spatial Planning and Land Use Management	Registered Town and Regional Planner	5 years or more
1.4. Economics	B(Hons) Economics	3 years or more
1.5. Engineering	Professional Engineer in Civil/ Electrical/ structural or Transport	5 years or more

Each nomination must be in writing (indicate if it is for the MPT or Appeal Authority) and must include the following information or details: **A) Full names and address of the nominator**, who must be a natural persons and a person may nominate himself or herself or organization nominate the candidate. **B) Nominations accompanied by acceptance letter C) Short CV of the nominee D) Motivation by the nominator** of the appointment of the nominee **E) Copy of ID document F) Certified copies of qualifications, registration certificates and letter of Good standing** (indicating registration with relevant professional or voluntary association).

NB: It must be noted that all nominees will be vetted and evaluated (by the Evaluation Panel), before official appointment is made by Council.

Remunerations: The successful candidate will be remunerated in accordance with Treasury Regulations that regulate the remuneration of commissions and committees of inquiry. Nominees from government sector (local, provincial and national) will not be remunerated.

Disqualification: Please note that the failure to comply with the above requirements and the provisions of section 38 of the Spatial Planning and Land Use Management Act (Act 16 of 2013) and Section 16&19 of Musina Local Municipality Spatial Planning and Land Use Management By-law, 2016, may result in the disqualification of the nomination.
